The View

Now that Spring is officially here, it's time to start getting ourselves and our boats ready for the season ahead. BBSPS is offering a batch of neat programs from evening seminars to full courses and on-water training in the coming months.

We attended the Spring District Conference in New Bedford and I presented a session on **What's New in Electronics**. If you are interested, I would gladly repeat the presentation on Zoom in the coming month.

The big news at the conference was presented by our new Chief, Craig Fraser. A team was formed last year to recommend a reorganization of USPS. Their plan was approved at the annual meeting and is underway with a projected completion by June of 2023. Simply put, we presently have a complex three-tier structure. To simplify, the district level will be officially eliminated. This means the squadrons (now considered "clubs") will interact directly with the national organization. We are free to form a consortium of squadrons to cooperate, but there will be no formal reporting structure. A lot of other changes to simplify the overall structure are being considered. A great deal of the plan derives from the results of a member-wide on-line poll last fall.

Dick Moore has announced a wide-ranging set of programs for Spring and early Summer. We are emphasizing boat handling, navigation, and using equipment. We have a great number of new members and still many people are moving into (or returning to) boating and want to build their skills. That's what we are here to do.

We will continue our live, online, virtual sessions interspersed with selected face-to-face meetings for hands-on training.

On April 9th, we will be meeting at the Holiday Inn in Falmouth for a social event and presentation on steam boats and related equipment. We also will perform our annual change of watch in a brief session.

By the way, BBSPS was awarded 2^{nd} place in 2021 membership growth nationally at 16.7% in our squadron size group. Congratulations all!

Sign-up for some of our activities and let's get together to prepare for boating.

Looking Around – On the Water

Bob Sweet

The marine industry is moving to new technologies to help us on the water. A lot of it involves video. As a boater, you literally need your head on a swivel to watch all directions, spot other boats, and ease up to the dock. These new tools will work with your chartplotter display to make your job easier.

Let's begin with simple cameras. These obviously need to be tailored to the marine environment, but they perform much like cameras you may use at home. Most chartplotters and multifunction displays can show video from these cameras. There are two types – wired and wireless. Obviously, wireless makes for somewhat easier installation, but you still need power to the cameras.

So, where do you put cameras? For view underway, you would like to see astern of the boat with a relatively wide field of view. For docking, you want cameras looking downward along the sides and stern of the boat. Some cameras have pan and tilt so they can be steered; otherwise, you may need several cameras. Typical cameras cost between \$175 and \$750.

So much for just looking at a video screen, a number of companies have added some smarts. For example, Raymarine has a system they call Clear Cruise®. You get a special camera and a control box. Connect this to your Axiom display and magic happens. Let's assume you also have an AIS receiver or transceiver as well. Then, with the camera facing forward, its stabilized image is shown on the display with identifying tags over the boats with their AIS identities shown. Their respective distances are also shown. In addition, you can have your waypoints tagged on the screen. Same thing for buoys that have AIS identities. This rig will set you back about \$1500.

Let's say you boat at night and want to stay safe. Your best bet is a FLIR camera. These cameras sense infrared – in other words, they see heat rather than visible light. That is perfect for boating, even with no ambient light around. A pan-and-tilt adjustable camera with zoom lens is a bit costly at around \$3500, but you can't beat the performance. FLIR is the company that owns Raymarine, so they make a great pair. As an alternative, you can get a handheld FLIR monocular for about \$2500.

If you are really concerned about docking and have an expensive boat, you might want an even more sophisticated system. Raymarine offers DockSense® and Garmin offers SurroundView®. These systems use multiple cameras to create a "bumper" around the boat so you see exactly where you are relative to the dock or other obstacles. These are more or less factory installed systems costing as much as \$18,000. But it may be worth it to ensure your multi-million-dollar yacht doesn't crash into a dock. Nobody said this is an inexpensive sport!


