AMERICA'S BOATING COURSE 2023 SCHEDULE

America's Boating Course (ABC) is recognized as one of the very best ways to prepare yourself for boating.

ABC meets NASBLA certification requirements, is recognized by the U.S. Coast Guard, and meets MA requirements for boat operation by 12-15 year-old boaters.

ABC covers the basics of operating a boat safely, including rules of the road, aids to navigation, required equipment, and boat handling techniques.

Each class is a live, interactive, virtual presentation using ZOOM on 4 weekday evenings followed by a "drive in" in-person, proctored exam given the Sunday morning following the last class.

Do you know how to use your Electronics on board?

Bob Sweet

Electronics have vastly improved boating, especially GPS. Unfortunately, these gadgets can be confounding to use. The manufacturers write manuals that could substitute for puzzles rather than offering easily usable instructions.

GPS was the game-changer for navigation. The satellites provide a highly-accurate threedimensional position. Today, most of us use a chartplotter which places our boat's position directly on a chart displayed on the screen. To be useful on a boat, these devices need to be waterproof and have displays bright enough to be seen in daylight.

To control the chartplotter we need buttons, but waterproof buttons are expensive. So, the manufacturers only use a few, if any. Finding the right button is key. Touchscreens have become popular and those units often have only virtual buttons that show up on the screen. Almost all of the functions on your chartplotter are programmed into the unit by the engineers that designed it. They had their own ideas of where to hide things.

This leads to multi-tier menus. Somewhere in there is the function that I want. How do I find it? Once I find it, how do I use it? If your chartplotter is mounted on your boat, you can't practice at home. So when do I get to learn how to use it? When you are on the boat, you want to be boating not learning to use the chartplotter. Adding to the confusion, each brand has a different layout and menu.

You can do your navigation planning at home, but how do you get it into the chartplotter? There is software you can use at home and simple ways to transfer what you planned to the chartplotter.

You can get a head start on your boating by taking our **Boating and Navigating with Electronics Seminar**. The virtual, live, online seminar walks you through the basic functions on your chartplotter and how to manage them. In most cases you can do planning at home or on your tablet and transfer your plans to the chartplotter. In that way you can spend most of your boating time actually boating. The next session is scheduled for Tuesday evening, March 14th.

In addition to the chartplotter, the other device I get lots of questions about is radar. Radar presents a useful display of what is around you above the surface of the water, but it is not intuitive. And, there are a bunch of controls. What am I seeing? How do I interpret what it is telling me? We also talk about that in the seminar.

We also have a companion two-part online seminar called **Basic Coastal Navigation** which is being offered on Tuesday evenings on April 18 and 25. This is basically a solid introduction to coastal navigation for new boaters and a refresher for those who have experience but want to better relate to their electronics.

As boating season approaches, we offer support to our members on their boats to help them with their electronics, as well as handling their boats. Be sure to ask.




